McNeely School Safety Plan

Regular School Hours 8:45-2:45 – Two days a weekOur welcome bell to enter the school rings at 8:40am

Morning Arrival Routine:

Students will enter the building through our outside doors. Please line up outside our door, allowing 2 metres between children. Parents are not allowed to enter the building.

Students will wash their hands with soap & water upon arrival at school.

1. Personal Hygiene:

Hand washing will be incorporated into our daily schedule, specifically:

- Before and after any breaks (e.g., recess, lunch)
- Between different learning environments (e.g., outdoor-indoor)
- Before and after eating and drinking
- After using the washroom
- After sneezing or coughing into hands
- Whenever hands are visibly dirty

Helpful reminders for your children:

Cough or sneeze into elbows/sleeves or a tissue. Throw away used tissues and immediately wash hands. Try not to touch eyes, nose or mouth.

2. Physical Distancing:

How this will look at school? We will:

- Try to avoid close greetings (e.g., hugs, handshakes)
- Have the children spread out in the room, with each child having their own work space
- Recess/snack times will be staggered throughout the school to provide a greater amount of space for everyone
- Spend a great deal of time outside

3. **Eating**:

- Children need to come to school with ALL the food they need for the day. Lunches MAY
 NOT be dropped off at this time to limit the external contacts in the school.
- The fountains have been turned off. Children need to bring water bottles to school our special 'touchless' water bottle filling station will be in operation.
- June Birthdays if you would like to share a birthday treat with your classmates, the goodies must be prepackaged items such as Rice Krispie squares, or fruit snacks. We cannot allow homemade items at this time.

4. Materials:

 The children will have their own individual supplies with materials they might needed (i.e. pencils, crayons, markers, glue sticks etc.)

Home time Routine:

Children will wash their hands before they exit through our outside doors. For pick up, please ensure you are spaced 2m apart as you wait for your child to come out.

For Your Information:

OUTDOOR LEARNING:

We will spend a great deal of time outdoors each day. Please ensure your child brings a **hat** & **sunscreen** and wears comfortable **shoes**!

SICKNESS:

If a child arrives to school ill or becomes ill during the day, they will wait in a designated health room, isolated from the other children, for you to pick them up.

CLEANING:

Regular cleaning will be done throughout the day, focussing on high touch areas. Regular disinfection will be done at the end of each day as well, with a particular deep clean occurring on Wednesdays prior to the second group attending on Thursday and Friday.
